List of eLeMeNt ZX compatible peripherals

The eLeMeNt ZX is fully compatible with an old ZX Spectrum hardware, has a real Z80-CPU and performs exact timings of all implemented Speccy models. It can be used with both old and new ZX interfaces.

In order to achieve the highest level of compatibility, the eLeMeNt's system expansion bus provides a combination of the all important signals from several types of ZX Spectrum models. More details are in the User's manual.

In order to operate a K-Mouse implemented in the eLeMeNt ZX, an USB mouse has to support a PS/2 protocol.
